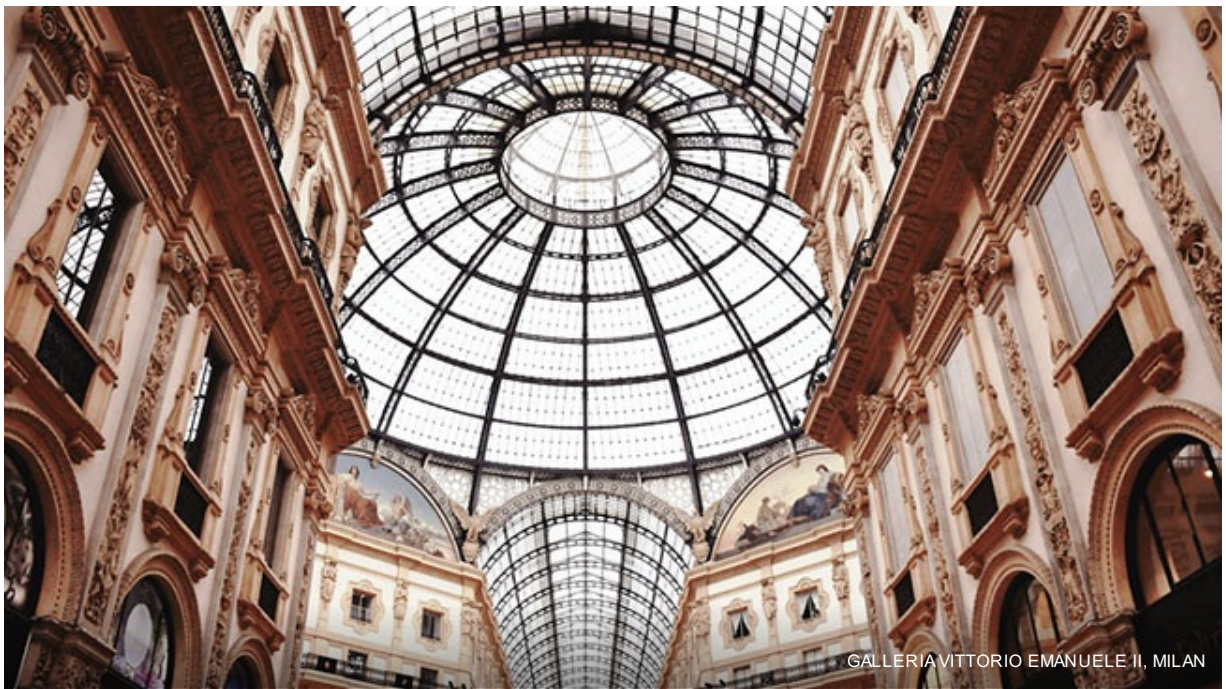

Day 2 & 3: Shared Gran Tour of Milan with Last Supper

Milan is one of the world's top fashion capitals, but this trendy metropolis also boasts an extraordinary artistic and cultural heritage, including **Leonardo da Vinci's masterpiece The Last Supper**. Guarantee your visit to this world-famous work with this best-selling tour, which includes advance booking, skip-the-line tickets, and a half-day tour of Milan.

Housed at Santa Maria delle Grazie and listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, The Last Supper is just one of Milan's highlights. Your half-day tour also includes a walking visit through Italy's most stylish city: explore the *Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II*, a 19th-century glass-roofed arcade filled with elegant shops and cafés and known as the "Salotto di Milano".

Visit the medieval *Sforza Castle*, once home to Milan's ruling family and now host to important museums and art collections. Continue to the magnificent *Duomo*, one of the world's largest Gothic cathedrals, featuring 135 spires and 3,200 statues. Finally, discover *La Scala Opera House*, founded in 1778 and still active today. Many of the world's greatest musicians and singers, including Pavarotti and Verdi, have performed here. Your ticket grants 24-hour access to both the theatre and its museum.

Day 2 & 3: Shared Navigli Canal Cruise with Aperitif

Cruising the Navigli is one of the most authentic ways to get to know the real Milan. Doing it while enjoying the evening breeze, sipping a good glass of wine is even better.

The Navigli district is famous for its canals and vibrant evening life. With this tour you will have the pleasure of cruising along the Naviglio Grande sipping an excellent cocktail and tasting good food. Aperitivo in Milan is the combination of drinks and fingerfood. You will see the typical Milanese railing houses, which represent the Milan of the past, now home to numerous bars and restaurants, going upstream to one of the oldest churches in the city: the Church of San Cristoforo, whose construction began in the 13th century.

You will see the historic headquarters of Canottieri Milano Olona and the famous alley of the launderers, an architectural jewel that takes its name from the residents who washed their laundry there, all in complete relaxation and in a convivial atmosphere. If you want, you can also listen to our audio guide, to learn a bit of history, or simply enjoy the navigation while chatting with your friends about the beauties of Milan.

The newest alpine delight! Take a ride on the Bernina Panoramic Train along one of the world's most spectacular railway routes. A UNESCO World Heritage site, travel across the Swiss Alps along the Bernina Pass to the exclusive resort of St. Moritz; the 'Top of the World'.

Your journey starts amid the palms of Tirano, northern Italy, taking you over the spiraling Brusio viaduct and through the Bernina Pass (2253 metres above the sea level) into the Engadin Valley before arriving at St. Moritz. Along the way you'll pass wild gorges and icy glaciers, cross soaring bridges and shoot through loop tunnels. This north-south Alpine crossing offers breathtaking views and stunning scenery as you travel

over boldly curved viaducts and through winding tunnels. After the train journey you will visit the exclusive resort of St. Moritz, enjoy free time to explore the 'Top of the World' before returning to Milan by air-conditioned coach.

Day 3: Private Full Day Excursion to Lake Como from Milan

The day will begin with the pickup in the lobby of your hotel. The driver collecting you and within an hour, you will reach Lake Como and continue driving along the panoramic lake road SS 340 until your first tour stop: Villa Carlotta (entrance ticket and visit not included)

The property was lastly owned by the Italian explorer and philanthropist Guido Monzino, who donated the building and gardens to the FAI (National Trust of Italy). The Villa now hosts an extremely beautiful, rich and complete museum of Monzino's expeditions and also includes many art masterpieces of his collection. More recently the property was used as movie-set for James Bond: Casino Royale and Star Wars: II Episode films. You will then proceed with a car-ferry ride that arrives to the famous town of Bellagio. After that, you can enjoy some free lunch-time in town with a stunning panorama, shop at world-class stores and admire the centuries-old architecture.

After lunch (not included) the tour will conclude, and your private driver will take you back to your hotel in Milan.
