ITINERARY

Day 1 Depart Pretoria

Depart from Rovos Rail Station in Pretoria, traveling southeast across the Highveld and goldfields. Freshen up in your suite before joining others in the lounge and observation cars. Enjoy lunch onboard while taking in views of the majestic Drakensberg Mountains. Later, the train climbs Majuba Hill and passes Newcastle, home to the largest cella-dome Hindu temple in the southern hemisphere. Dinner (formal) is served as you head to Elandsplaagte. Pass Glencoe, site of the first battle of the Anglo Boer War and now the centre of the province's coalfields

Day **2**

Nambiti & Spionkop

After breakfast, embark on a thrilling game drive through the malaria-free Nambiti Reserve, a private 20,000-acre Big Five sanctuary boasting diverse ecosystems. Brunch awaits onboard before transferring to Spionkop Lodge. Choose between a historic tour of the Battle of Spionkop site or a nature drive through the adjoining 11,000-acre reserve. Return to the train for dinner en route to Estcourt. Shortly after Chieveley, on the right of the track, stands a memorial to Winston Churchill who was captured here in November 1899 while trying to free an armoured train trapped by a Boer ambush.

Ardmore Ceramics

After breakfast, the train descends the escarpment to Lions River. Visit the renowned Ardmore Ceramics Gallery, where local artists bring Zulu folklore and nature to life through their craft. Enjoy lunch onboard as the train winds through the breathtaking Valley of a Thousand Hills. The journey concludes at Durban Station, a vibrant city known for its museums, botanical gardens, and stunning shark-protected beaches.
