Day **1**

Board the Indian Pacific in Sydney

Departing Sydney's Central Station mid-afternoon, leave city skylines and the fast-paced urban lifestyle behind. Day 2

Broken Hill Adelaide

The day begins with a stop in Broken Hill, one of Australia's most historic outback towns. Guests disembark for an immersive Off Train Experience, choosing either to explore the region's rich mining heritage, including the Miners' Memorial, or enjoy a unique and entertaining experience with local personality Shelita Buffet, featuring food, creativity, and plenty of character. Refreshments are provided before returning to the train.

Back onboard the Indian Pacific, breakfast and lunch are served as the train travels through the striking landscapes of regional South Australia, passing the southern reaches of the Flinders Ranges.

Later in the day, the journey reaches Adelaide, where a selection of specially curated experiences is available. Guests may choose to discover the renowned wineries of McLaren Vale and enjoy dinner overlooking the coast at the Star of Greece, or head to the Adelaide Hills for locally crafted gin, regional cheeses, and a German-inspired dinner at Haus. Other options include an insider's tour and tasting at Coopers Brewery, combined with city sightseeing and a Teppanyaki dinner at Shiki, or a guided exploration of Adelaide Central Market, culminating in an exclusive dining experience within the market itself.

Following an evening of food, wine, and local discoveries, guests rejoin the train and continue their transcontinental journey westward through the night.

Nullarbor Plain

By evening, you'll reach Rawlinna, on the edge of Australia's largest sheep station. Here, the outback comes alive as you dine beneath a canopy of stars at a spectacular signature long-table dinner (Sept - May). In the cooler months, gather around a roaring bondire with drinks and canapés, soaking up the atmosphere of this remarkable setting.
