Furthermore, since Raiatea shares its lagoon with the neighboring island of Taha'a, why not seize the opportunity to make a stop there? Dive into the coral garden for a mesmerizing snorkeling adventure, visit a pearl farm to witness the magic of pearl cultivation, and explore a vanilla plantation, unraveling the secrets behind this renowned spice.
