Zurich

Individual travel by train to Zurich. As a lakeside "metropolis of experiences", with a magnificent view of the snow-capped Alps on the horizon, Zurich offers an unique mixture of attractions.

2

Zurich Jungfrauoch Interlaken

Breakfast at the hotel.

Train ride via Lucerne to Interlaken along the shores of crystal-clear lakes, past romantic waterfalls and over the magnificent Brünig mountain pass.

The journey to the **Jungfrauoch** at 3,454 meters - *Europe's highest altitude railway station* - is a highlight of every visit to Switzerland. The Jungfrau Railway is an engineering masterpiece. The last section has been built inside the mountain itself,

and the view through the panorama windows at the "*Eigerwand*" and "*Eismeer*" stations in the middle of the North Wall are a thrilling experience. The platform of the observatory is located right above the Aletsch Glacier. The "*Alpine Sensation*" a subway inside the rock connects the Ice Paradise with the Sphinx Hall.
