ITINERARY

Day 1 Bilbao Santander

Commencement of the journey begins with a reception at Concordia-Bilbao station at 10 a.m., where guests will be introduced to the crew and familiarised with the train's accommodations. The day unfolds with a panoramic tour of Bilbao, including a visit to the renowned Guggenheim Museum. Lunch will be served on board as the train departs for Santander. Upon arrival, an afternoon exploration of the city awaits, allowing for free time and an evening dinner at a local restaurant. The night will be spent onboard the train in the charming city of Santander.

Day 2 Santander Santillana del Mar Llanes

The morning begins with breakfast on board as you approach Cabezón de la Sal. A bus will then transport guests to the Altamira Cave and the medieval town of Santillana del Mar. Lunch will be enjoyed in the charming surroundings of Santillana del Mar. Following this, the train continues its journey into the Asturias region, offering a tour, dinner on board, and an overnight stay in the picturesque town of Llanes.

Day 3 Llanes Oviedo

For 2025: Following breakfast, your journey continues with a bus ride to Cangas de Onís, the first capital of the Kingdom of Asturias. From there, guests will get the opportunity to delve into the heart of the Picos de Europa, exploring the Covadonga Sanctuary and Lake Enol. Afterwards, return to the train for lunch and set off for Oviedo. The day includes a tour of Oviedo, followed by dinner and an overnight stay in this captivating city.

For 2026: After breakfast, you'll travel by coach to Arenas de Cabrales, nestled in the heart of the Picos de Europa. There, you visit the Cabrales Cheese Cave-Museum and explore the village. Lunch will be served on board as the train continues to Oviedo. Upon arrival, enjoy a guided visit of the city, followed by dinner and an overnight stay in Oviedo.

Day **4** Oviedo Luarca

After a delightful breakfast, the train takes guests to the lively coastal city of Gijón, allowing for some leisure time to explore. Following lunch, the train will transport guests to Luarca for a guided tour. Dinner will be served on the train and the day concludes with an overnight stay onboard.

Day **5** Luarca Viveiro

During breakfast, the train reaches Ribadeo, initial stop in Galicia. Explore the area, enjoy some free time, and have lunch in Ribadeo. In the afternoon, the train will proceed to Viveiro. Explore the town, have dinner on board, and spend the night in Viveiro.

Day **6** Viveiro Santiago de Compostela

On the final day, guests will enjoy breakfast, as the train reaches Ferrol. After bidding farewell to the crew, you will embark on a bus journey to Santiago de Compostela, the capital of Galicia. Explore the city, have lunch and your tour will end at the Parador de los Reyes Católicos at approximately 1600hrs. Your journey concludes here.
