Day **3**

Tracy Arm Inlet Juneau

This morning, Koningsdam sails into the dramatic Tracy Arm Inlet, a narrow fjord carved deep into Alaska's wilderness. Towering granite cliffs rise sharply from the water, topped with snow-covered peaks and ancient temperate rainforest that has reclaimed the landscape since the last Ice Age. As the ship glides farther into the inlet, drifting ice signals the approach to the spectacular Sawyer Glaciers, where massive blue slabs of ice calve into the sea.

Part of the vast Tongass National Forest, Tracy Arm is one of Alaska's most pristine environments and offers excellent opportunities for wildlife viewing. Keep watch for seals resting on ice floes, whales surfacing in the channel, and mountain goats clinging to the steep slopes. This is a true highlight of the journey, best enjoyed from open decks or panoramic lounges, with warm layers and rain gear recommended for changing weather.

Arrive in Juneau, Alaska's scenic capital, set between mountains, rainforest, and waterways. The city offers easy access to nearby glaciers, excellent seafood, and rich local history at the state capitol. Popular experiences include the Mount Roberts Tramway, whale-watching excursions, and optional flightseeing to remote wilderness areas known for bear sightings. Though small in size, Juneau is Alaska's most visited cruise port and a memorable highlight of the journey.

Day 4

Skagway

Arrive by cruise ship into historic Skagway, once the main gateway to the Klondike Gold Rush and now a well-preserved step back into frontier Alaska. The compact town is easy to explore on foot and is part of the Klondike Gold Rush National Historical Park, with restored buildings, museums, shops, and local eateries near the pier. A highlight for many cruise guests is the scenic White Pass & Yukon Route Railway, which climbs into the mountains past waterfalls, gorges, and glaciers, offering unforgettable views of the dramatic landscape surrounding this classic port town.

Day 5

Glacier Bay

On your cruise to Glacier Bay, close your eyes and take in the sounds—the creaks and groans of “living” ice, the shrill cries of gulls and soaring eagles, the splash of a breaching humpback whale. Frosted peaks towering over mossy forests, wide

tidewater glaciers (there are seven in the park), and marine wildlife are given on Glacier Bay cruises, but every experience in this changing biosphere is unique. There are glaciers, fjords, inlets, rivers, streams and wildlife galore on Glacier Bay cruises, so bring those binoculars.

Ketchikan

Cruise into Ketchikan, known as Alaska's "First City" and a colourful port along the Inside Passage. Famous for its fishing heritage and Native Alaskan culture, the town features impressive totem poles at parks and cultural centers, as well as living traditions showcased in nearby Native villages. Stroll historic Creek Street, a scenic boardwalk built over Ketchikan Creek, lined with galleries, shops, and waterside restaurants serving fresh local seafood. Ketchikan offers an engaging mix of culture, history, and coastal scenery.

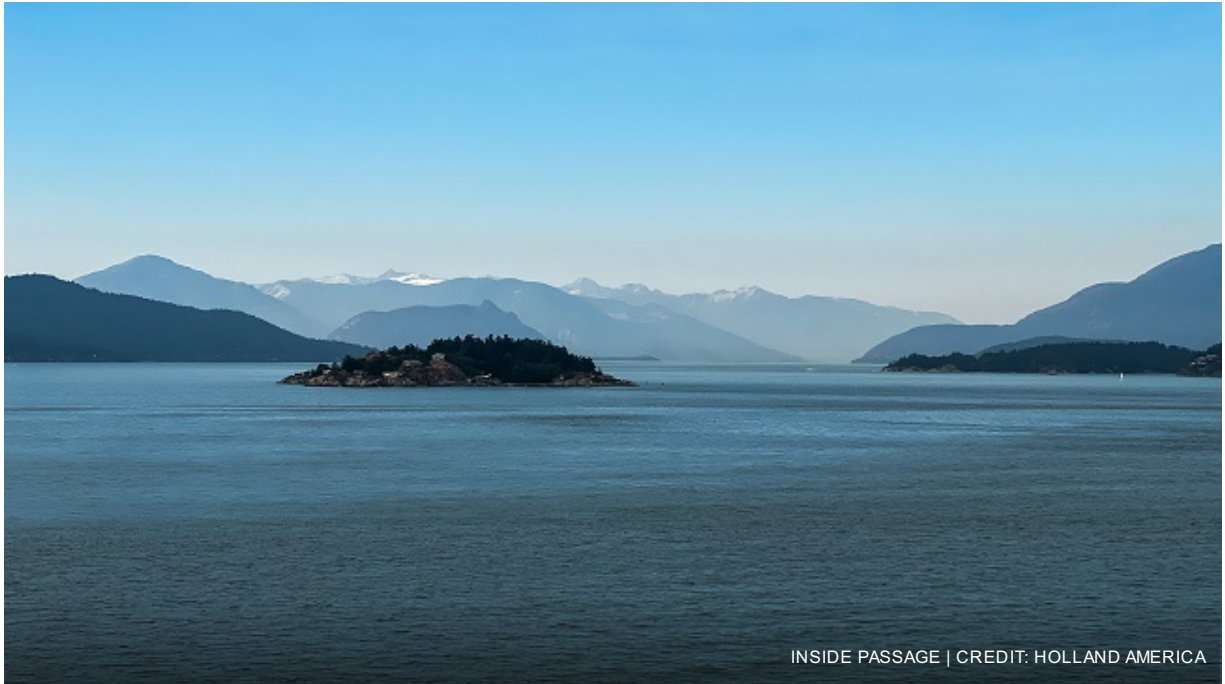
Day **7**

On today's journey, you will see dramatic changes in scenery, from the lush green fields of the Fraser Valley, through forests and winding river canyons surrounded by the peaks of the Coast and Cascade Mountains, to the desert-like landscapes of the BC interior. Highlights include the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon and the steep

slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River. Your day ends in the evening as the train travels along the shores of Kamloops Lake into the town of Kamloops

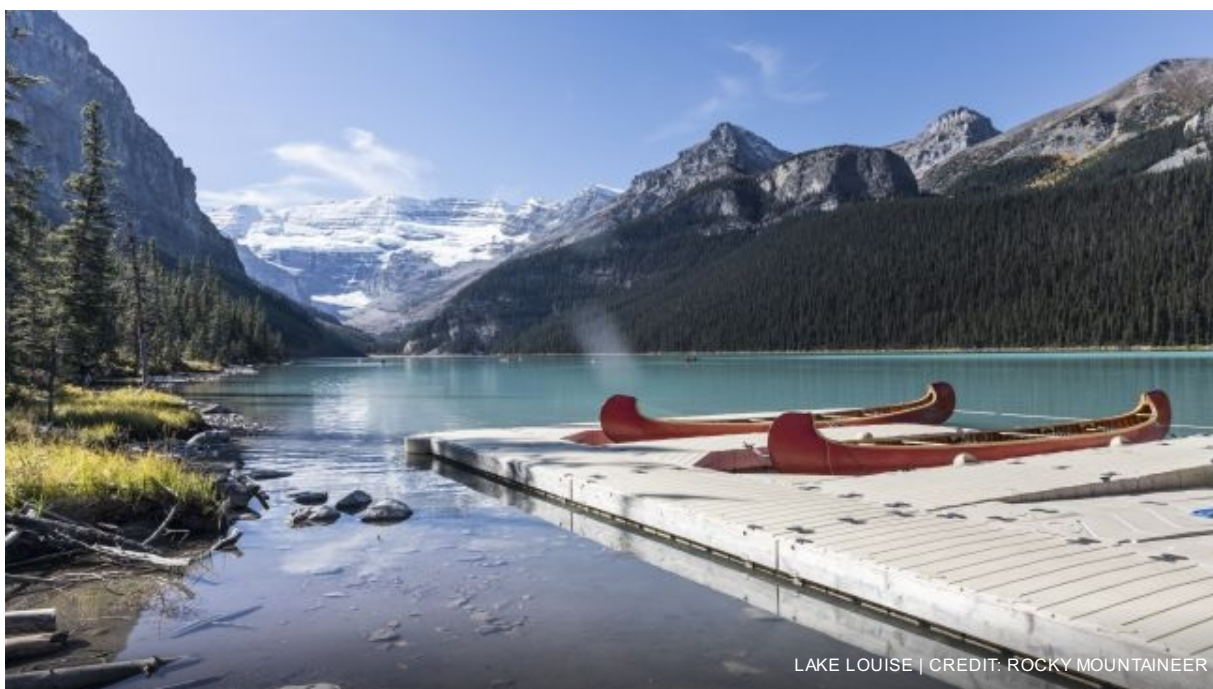

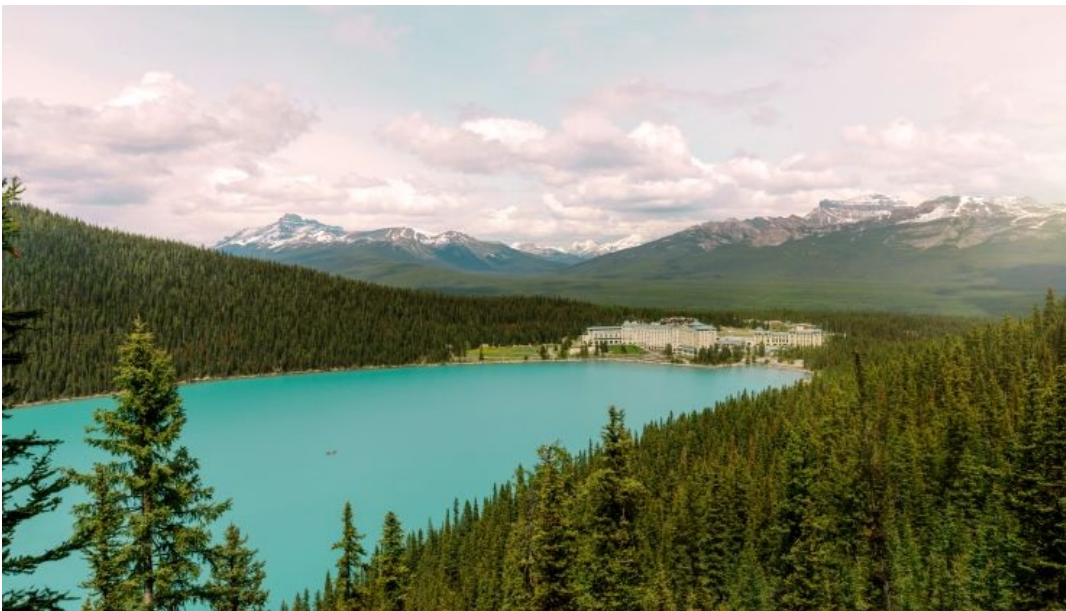
