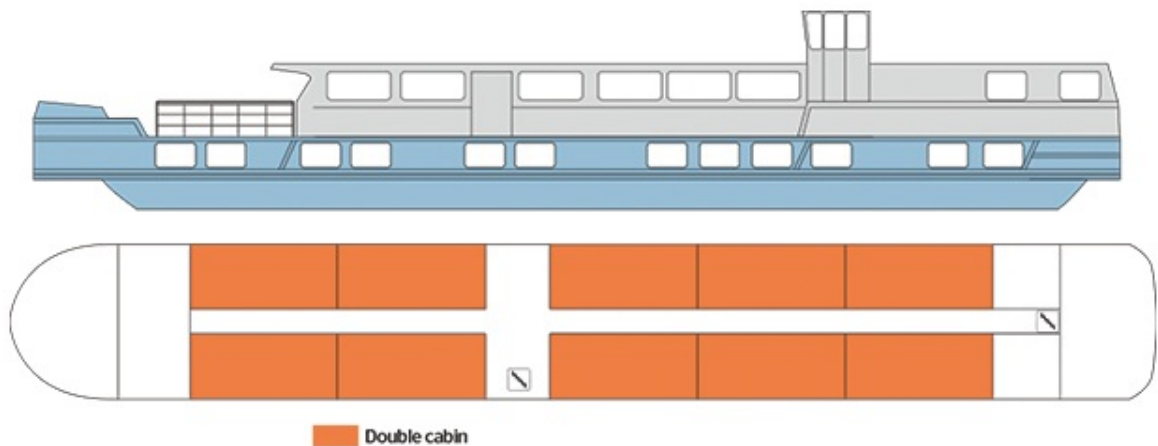
- Canal cruise, measuring 38.5m long and 5m wide

Passengers may board the ship at 6:00 p.m in Paris. After settling into your cabins, the crew will be introduced during a welcome cocktail before dinner. Tonight, you'll savour dinner onboard, followed by a traditional Titi Parisien show. Later, enjoy a scenic night cruise through Paris (subject to water levels). The ship will stay in the heart of the city overnight.

The Canal Saint Martin - PARIS and its famous sites

The morning begins with a leisurely cruise along the Canal Saint-Martin, passing through the heart of authentic Parisian neighbourhoods.

The afternoon will be dedicated to a guided tour of Paris, bringing you to some of the important sites in the French capital: The Place de la Republique, the grand boulevards, Palais Garnier, Madeleine Church, Place Vendôme and the Louvre. Leaving from the Palais-Royal, you'll walk through the unique Parisian covered walkways.

During the holidays, the covered walkways are marvelously decorated to dazzle the eyes. Take in the festive and colourful atmosphere while shopping in traditional boutiques. The ship will spend Christmas Eve docked at the Quai d'Austerlitz.

Day 3 Paris and the Saint-Germain-des-Prés district

The morning begins with a scenic cruise along the Seine, offering breathtaking views of Paris' most iconic landmarks. Glide past Île Saint-Louis, Île de la Cité—where Notre Dame still stands majestically—the Louvre, Tuileries Garden, Pont Alexandre III, and, of course, the Eiffel Tower with its Trocadéro Gardens. The ship will dock at Quai de Grenelle.

In the afternoon, embark on a panoramic tour of Saint-Germain-des-Prés, a historic hub of Parisian culture. Travel along the renowned Triumphant Way, passing the Arc de Triomphe, Champs-Élysées, and Place de la Concorde before reaching this charming district. Highlights include the city's oldest church, dating back to 543, and the legendary Café de Flore, once a gathering place for great intellectuals and artists like Jean-Paul Sartre, Simone de Beauvoir, and Pablo Picasso.

Later, enjoy free time to explore a festive Parisian Christmas market, soaking in the holiday atmosphere. The evening concludes with a festive gala dinner onboard
