ITINERARY

Day 1

Vancouver

Day **2**

Vancouver Kelowna

Kelowna Golden

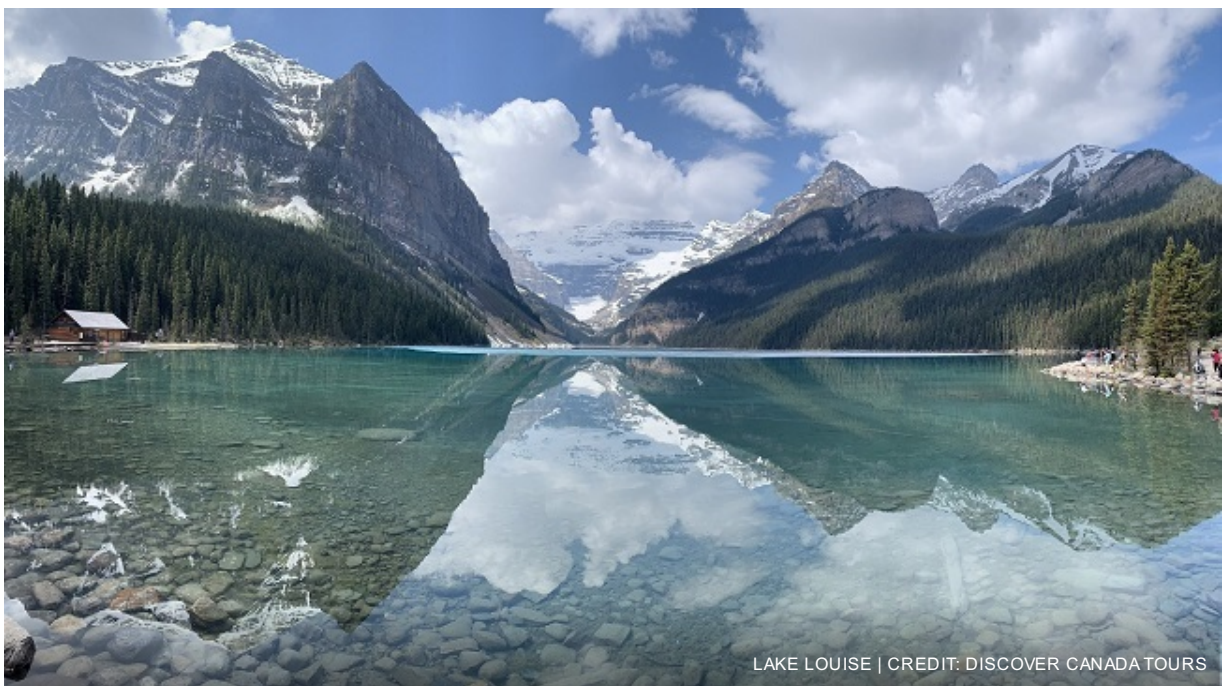
Day **4**
